Welcome to **Kulusuk** Airport

Kulusuk Airport is situated in the south eastern region of Greenland. It is the nearest airport to Iceland in Greenland and as such it is a popular choice for smaller aircrafts on route between Europe and America.

Kulusuk was built by the US defense in 1956, in order to support a Distant Early Warning Line station. The defense station was closed in 1991. Like some other airports in Greenland it was not built at a location with civil transportation in mind. However, today the airport is used solely for civil transportation with regular routes to Nuuk, the nearby settlement Tasiilaq and Iceland. The Airport has an 1199 meter gravel runway.

Kulusuk Airport offers a range of services including de-icing

facilities. The terminal building hosts a small cafeteria, a museum and a duty-free stand in the departures/arrivals hall. Accessible restrooms are available for pilots, as well as limited Internet access are provided on request.
